The 2014-15 year has been another strong year for our Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation as we celebrated our 35th year of service to the children of Pennsylvania.

First, I would like to thank all of our donors - the clubs, individuals and organizations who allow us to give back to our communities. Thank you, we couldn't do it without you. I hope that everyone makes our Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation a philanthropic priority so that we can continue to grow and support even more initiatives.

The Early Learning Program continues to grow and become a hallmark program for our Foundation. This year, we introduced "Every Day I Learn Through Play" as the 3rd printed piece in the series, bringing our total up to 130,000 since the program began.

This year, we transitioned our scholarship process to include online applications. This provided an improved outreach to the students. I am proud to report that this year, we were able to award the first Don and Myrt Nieman Endowed Scholarships to four former service leadership program members who will be attending graduate school this year.

Providing hands-on service is important to our Foundation and we were proud to support grants for the Kiwanis Club of Dillsburg "Kiwanis Grove" playground project, the Nurse-Family Partnership of Allegheny County, and right here at the Erie 2015 District Convention as we're sponsoring the service fair.

On behalf of the children we impact as Kiwanis members every day, thank you for your continued support of our Foundation. If I can be of any assistance, please do not hesitate to contact me.

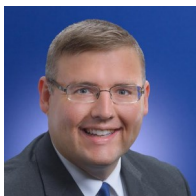

## 2014-2015: Year in Review

### Early Learning Initiative

Kiwanis in Pennsylvania continues to work and partner with the Pennsylvania Early Learning Investment Commission as a strategic partner of the Commission. Commission members have joined Kiwanis and through the Commission, Kiwanis is well recognized in Pennsylvania State Government for its work in the area of Early Childhood Education and Development. Our association with the Commission has brought us the program and strongly leveraged the dollars we have invested in the program.

This year, our Foundation approved a grant of over \$23,000 to support the efforts of Pennsylvania Kiwanians in the printing and distribution of Early Learning Guides to be distributed to families across the state of Pennsylvania. Through the work of Kiwanis clubs, to date, we have been able to impact children in 55 of Pennsylvania's 67 counties. Clubs that are interested in distributing guides in their community can contact the District Office for pick up or delivery options.





## 2014-2015: Year in Review

### Service Leadership Program: Leadership Building

The Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation continued our commitment to support the Pennsylvania Service Leadership organization by providing over \$14,000 in support of leadership building activities.

This year, our outreach provided \$75 scholarships to each of the 75 participants in the Key Leader program at Camp Conrad Weiser. Key Leader is a weekend experiential leadership program for today's young leaders.



Through our support of Key Club and Circle K, we were able to provide valuable resources for their leadership training and development, and hands-on service including Circle K's InterPACK.

### Convention Service Fair

Our Foundation is proud to partner with Division 1 to bring hands-on service to the Erie 2015 District Convention.

All Kiwanis family members are encouraged to participate in the projects that will be distributed throughout the greater Erie area.







## 2014-2015: Year in Review

### Dillsburg Elementary School Playground

Working with the Kiwanis Club of Dillsburg Area, our Foundation provided a \$5,000 grant that will be used toward the construction of a new Kiwanis Grove playground at the Dillsburg Elementary School. The club will be providing labor during a community-build construction, and has utilized the Key Club of Northern York County High School and the K-Kids of Dillsburg Elementary School as consultants during the playground equipment selection process.



### Nurse-Family Partnership of Allegheny County

Our outreach is providing resources such as diapers, high chairs, books, and educational opportunities to young mothers and their children in Allegheny County. The Kiwanis Clubs of Allegheny County - Penn Hills, Wilksburg, Glenshaw, Baldwin, Sheradan, Verona-Rosedale, North Allegheny, Pittsburgh Airport Area, and Sewickley - along with individual donors are providing matching funds to assist the 236 mothers in the program.



### Rose Sale

The Foundation appreciates the support of the Kiwanis family clubs that sold roses during the annual Rose Sale. These funds provided valuable resources for both the clubs and our Foundation. ### **About the Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation**

The Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization. All contributions to the Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation are tax-deductible. The growth and success of the Foundation depends on the membership of the Pennsylvania District as well as outside businesses and organizations.

All Pennsylvania Kiwanians are members of the Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation. A 15 member elected board of directors is responsible for the operations of the Foundation. Five members are elected each year to a three-year term. The Board's leadership consists of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, elected by the Board.

Committees are organized to address the business of the Foundation. These committees include but are not limited to:

- Marketing & Public Relations
- Resource Development
- Rose Sale
- Scholarship

The Pennsylvania Kiwanis Foundation Board meets at four regularly scheduled meetings throughout the year and conducts our Annual Meeting at the annual District Convention.
